Glorious Saint Joseph, spouse of the Immaculate Virgin, obtain for me a pure, humble, charitable mind, and perfect resignation to the divine Will. Be my guide, my father, and my model through life that I may merit to die as you did in the arms of Jesus and Mary.

Annunciation Novena ~ March 17 – 25

I greet you, Ever-blessed Virgin, Mother of God, Throne of Grace, Sanctuary of the Most Holy Trinity and Queen of the Universe, Mother of Mercy and refuge of sinners!

Most loving Mother, attracted by your beauty and sweetness, and by your tender compassion, I confidently turn to you, miserable as I am, and beg of you to obtain for me from your dear Son the favor I request in this novena: (mention your request).

Novena to Our Lady of Fatima ~ May 4 – 12

Most Holy Virgin, who came to Fatima, Portugal to reveal to the three little shepherds Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia, the treasures of graces hidden in the recitation of the Rosary, inspire our hearts with a sincere love of this devotion, so that by meditating on the mysteries of our redemption, that are recalled in it, we may gather the fruits and obtain the conversion of sinners, the conversion of Russia, and this favor that I so earnestly seek which I ask of you in this novena (State your request here). Novena for the Ascension of Jesus ~ May 30 – June 7, 2025

(This date will change annually. Though this novena can be prayed any time of year, it is traditionally prayed from the Friday after Ascension Thursday (when the Ascension is not transferred to the following Sunday) until the Saturday before Pentecost. The recommended dates for 2025 are May 30-June 7.)

Jesus, I honor You on the feast of Your Ascension into heaven. I rejoice with all my heart at the glory into which You entered to reign as King of heaven and earth. When the struggle of this life is over, give me the grace to share Your joy and triumph in heaven for all eternity.

I believe that You entered into Your glorious Kingdom to prepare a place for me, for You promised to come again to take me to Yourself. Grant that I may seek only the joys of Your friendship and love, so that I may deserve to be united with You in heaven.

In the hour of my own homecoming, when I appear before Your Father to give an account of my life on earth, have mercy on me.

Jesus, in Your love for me You have brought me from evil to good and from misery to happiness. Give me the grace to rise above my human weakness. May Your Humanity give me courage in my weakness and free me from my sins.

Through Your grace, give me the courage of perseverance for You have called and justified me by faith. May I hold fast to the life You have given me and come to the eternal gifts You promised. You love me, dear Jesus. Help me to love You in return. I ask You to grant this special favor: (Mention your request).

By Your unceasing care, guide my steps toward the life of glory You have prepared for those who love You. Make me grow in holiness and thank You by a life of faithful service. Amen.

Novena Prayer to St. Elisha ~ June 5 – 16

O God, protector and redeemer of the human family, whose wonders have been proclaimed through the wonders accomplished by Your chosen prophets, You have bestowed the spirit of Elijah on Your prophet Elisha.

In Your kindness, grant us too an increase in the gifts of the Holy Spirit so that, living as prophets, we will bear constant witness to Your abiding presence and providence.

We ask this through Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for all eternity. Amen.

Sacred Heart Novena ~ June 18 – 26, 2025

(This date will change annually. The Sacred Heart of Jesus novena is traditionally prayed for nine days before the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart, which in 2025 is on June 27. The recommended dates for the novena in 2025 are June 18-26.)

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore You, I love You, and with lively sorrow for my sins, I offer myself to You. Make me humble, patient, pure and obedient to Your will. Grant, good Jesus, that I may live in You and for You. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, Your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

Novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary ~ June 19 – 27, 2025

(The date of this novena will change annually. It is traditionally prayed nine days prior to the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary celebrated on the Saturday following the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 2025 will be from June 19-27.)

Immaculate Heart of Mary, full of love for God and mankind, and of compassion for sinners, I consecrate myself entirely to you. I entrust to you the salvation of my soul. May my heart be ever united with yours, so that I may hate sin, love God, and my neighbor, and reach eternal life together with those whom I love.

Mediatrice of All Graces and Mother of Mercy, remember the infinite treasure which your Divine Son has merited by His sufferings and which He has confided to you for us, your children. Filled with confidence in your motherly Heart, which I venerate and love, I come to you with my pressing needs. Through the merits of your loving Heart, and for the sake of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, obtain for me the favor I ask: (mention your request).

Dearest Mother, if what I ask for should not be according to God's Will, pray that I may receive that which will be of greater benefit to my soul. May I experience the kindness of your motherly Heart and the power of your intercession with Jesus during life and at the hour of my death. Amen.

Novena Prayer St. Benedict ~ July 3 – 11

Glorious Saint Benedict, sublime model of virtue, pure vessel of God's grace! Behold me humbly kneeling at your feet. I implore you in your loving kindness to pray for me before the throne of God. To you I have recourse in the dangers that daily surround me. Shield me against my selfishness and my indifference to God and to my neighbor. Inspire me to imitate you in all things. May your blessing be with me always, so that I may see and serve Christ in others and work for His kingdom.

Graciously obtain for me from God those favors and graces which I need so much in the trials, miseries and afflictions of life. Your heart was always full of love, compassion and mercy toward those who were afflicted or troubled in any way. You never dismissed without consolation and assistance anyone who had recourse to you. I therefore invoke your powerful intercession, confident in the hope that you will hear my prayers and obtain for me the special grace and favor I earnestly implore. Novena Prayer to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel ~ July 7 – 16

O most beautiful flower of Mount Carmel, splendor of heaven, Blessed Mother of the Son of God and Mother of mine, support me by your never failing love and help and protect me. May I, unworthy as I am, come one day to exchange your scapular that I had the privilege to wear for the wedding garment of heaven, and dwell with you and all the saints of Carmel in the kingdom of your Son. Sweet Mother, I place this cause in your loving hands. O Mary, my Mother, I consecrate myself to you forever. I offer you my body with all its miseries, my soul with all its imperfections, and my heart with all its affections and desires. (2025 marks the 100th Anniversary of St. John Vianney's canonization.)

O God, you raised up humble St. John Vianney to show what one priest can do. Pour out your graces upon my priests, and all priests, that they follow this saint's example. So, in the words of St. John Vianney I pray:

I Love You, O my God. My only desire is to love You, until the last breath of my life.

I love You, O infinitely loveable God, and prefer to die loving You, rather than to live for an instant without You.

I Love You, O my God, and I desire only to go to Heaven, to have the happiness of loving You perfectly.

I love You, O my God, and my only fear is to go to Hell, because one will never have the sweet solace of loving You there.

O Mary, full of grace, help me to share, even just a little, in the fullness of grace so wonderfully bestowed on you in your Immaculate Conception. O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to you.

St. Andrew Christmas Novena ~ November 30 – December 24

While the origins of this prayer are uncertain, it is at least 100 years old and may have come from Ireland. If the St. Andrew novena was prayed as a regular nine-day novena, it would end on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8th. However, this novena is actually prayed much longer than nine days—it is prayed throughout all four weeks of Advent. It is piously believed that whoever recites the St. Andrew Christmas Novena Prayer FIFTEEN times each day from the feast of St. Andrew (November 30th) until Christmas Eve will obtain the favor requested. Here is the beautiful prayer:

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment

in which the Son of God was born of the most pure Virgin Mary,
at midnight, in Bethlehem, in piercing cold.

In that hour vouchsafe,

I beseech Thee, O my God, (mention personal intentions here)

to hear my prayer and grant my desires through the merits of Our Savior Jesus Christ,
and of His blessed Mother. Amen.

Novena Prayer to St. John of the Cross ~ December 5 – 14

O my loving Father, St. John of the Cross, obtain for me the grace of perfect abandonment to the holy will of God, that placing all my joy and hope in the Passion of my Savior, I may at last rest eternally with you in His glory. Obtain for me also the special grace I ask during this novena if it be for the glory of God and for my salvation (*mention your personal intentions here*).

Great St. John of the Cross, model of patience and heroic generosity, who for the glory of God and for the propagation of the holy reform of Carmel, endured so many trials, and undertook such heavy labors, finding, as did St. Paul, your joy in opprobrium, obtain from our Lord for me the grace of unalterable patience in adversity, that I may thereby glorify God, cleanse my soul of every stain, advance in the practice of solid virtue and obtain at last the crown promised to those who suffer for the love of God. Amen
